#### All Vendors:

- 1. The Backcountry Horsemen of California 2019 Rendezvous Committee may inspect vendors at any time. The Backcountry Horsemen of California 2019 Committee reserves the right to shut down any booth for non-compliance with any applicable law(s), operating outside of the requested and approved function(s), or operating in a disrespectful, immoral or unethical manner toward any patron, official, competitor, vendor, city employee or any other attendee of the event.
- 2. Certificate of Insurance is required listing the \$1 million listed as an additional NORCO CITY insured, showing it on the policy
- 3. Vendors requiring electricity will need to provide an extension cord.
- 4. Vendors provide all their own tables and chairs for set up.
- 5. Set up begins at 9:00am on Thursday, Tear down may begin after 4pm on Sunday
- 6. The grounds must be cleared of all vehicles after set up and one hour prior to opening
- 7. NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS must have proof of non-profit status.
- 8. Do not tear down prior to close of event
- 9. Food Vendors-Fire Extinguisher is required-please call re requirements and pricing on electrical.
- 10. Vendors must apply for seller permit showing secondary location at address of 3737 Crestview Dr, Norco, Ca 92860
- 11. Vendors must complete paperwork attached for Dept of Equalization
- 12. Vendors must sign liability waiver
