

During this competition come meet Ron, Sheila and the contestants to observe Dutch oven cooking in action. You will learn about the basics of Dutch oven cooking including essential equipment, temperature control, and cleaning/storage of the pots. Plus, you get free samples of the dishes, recipes, temperature control charts and a chance to vote for the best dish!

RENDEZVOUS DUTCH OVEN COOKING COMPETITION

RULES FOR THE COMPETITION

1. Contestants will provide their own ingredients to prepare their dish(es).
2. Contestants will provide their own cooking gear: Dutch ovens, charcoal chimneys, cooking utensils, prep table, Dutch oven cooking table or equivalent set-up, ash buckets, sample serving cups (4 oz. cups recommended), plastic silverware, serving utensils, hand sanitizer and food handlers gloves for direct food handling.
3. There will be no cooking on the ground.
4. The Mid Valley Unit will provide hot briquettes and a shovel.
5. There will be a sanitation station set up with hot water and garbage cans will be available.
6. Contestants will have their choice of cooking a main dish or a dessert or both. Provide copies of recipes for the public, if desired.
7. Each contestant cook station will be labeled (i.e., Team 1, 2, etc., for public voting purposes).
8. All cooking needs to be done on site starting at noon.
9. Provide samples of your dish(es) to spectators at 3 p.m. when the public vote starts.
10. Spectators will vote using tickets for their favorite main dish and dessert.
11. Prizes and certificates will be awarded based on the public vote for the best main dish and the best dessert.
12. Entry fee is \$20/contestant

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO DIAMOND BAR ARENA 6055 CENTRAL AVENUE, CERES, CA 95307

From South: Go north on Hwy 99 through Turlock to Keyes Road. Exit freeway. Turn left on Keyes Road. You will be headed west for 3 miles to Central Avenue. Turn left again. Travel south about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and enter Diamond Bar on your right.

From North: Going south on Hwy 99, pass through Modesto (good luck) and then Ceres. A couple of miles past Ceres take Keyes Road exit and turn right on Keyes Road. You will be headed west for 3 miles to Central Avenue. Turn left on Central. Travel south about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and enter Diamond Bar on your right.

From I-5: Take the Patterson City exit and follow the signs to Turlock. You will be traveling on West Main once you cross the San Joaquin River. Turn left on Central Avenue and go north for about 4 miles. Diamond Bar will be on your left.



VENDOR BOOTH POLICY

1. The Backcountry Horsemen of California 2026 Rendezvous Committee may inspect vendors at any time. The Backcountry Horsemen of California 2026 Rendezvous Committee reserves the right to shut down any booth for non-compliance with any applicable law(s), operating outside of the requested and approved function(s), or operating in a disrespectful, immoral or unethical manner toward any patron, official, competitor, vendor, city employee or any other attendee of the event.
2. Vendors requiring electricity will need to provide an extension cord.
3. Vendors provide their own EZ up, tables and chairs.
4. Set up begins at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 19. Tear down may begin Sunday morning, March 22.
5. The grounds must be cleared of all vehicles after set up and one hour prior to opening.
6. NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS must have proof of non-profit status.
7. Do not tear down prior to close of event.
8. Vendors must sign liability waiver for Diamond Bar and BCHC. Forms will be available on-site.
9. Deadline for mention in Program is February 15, 2026.
